## **REGISTRATION**

- Registration requires submitting payment for the 1st month's tuition and annual membership fee. The non-refundable fee is \$60 for new students and \$45 for returning students.
- A liability release accepted online by a parent is required before a student participates in a trial class or is officially enrolled at Studio 3.
- The registration process must be completed online at studio3dance.com.
- Rollover Membership will be offered in the spring of 2026 at a discounted rate for returning members who commit to enrollment for the next season. Info available in the spring of 2026.

#### **TUITION FEES & PAYMENTS**

- Tuition rates are for the full season (August through May), not by the number of classes in the month.
- Tuition is not prorated for absences, holidays, or cancellations due to bad weather or governmental advisory.
- A credit card on file is REQUIRED for all accounts. Credit card information is securely saved on your Studio Director family portal.
- After registering (paying for August tuition or 1st month's tuition and membership fee), monthly tuition (September-May) will be processed automatically with the debit or credit card saved to your account. To avoid having the card on file charged, pay by cash, check, or a different credit or debit card by the 25th of the previous month.
- Accounts not paid within terms are subject to a \$15 late fee for payments made after the 10th of the month.

 It is your responsibility to change expired or compromised credit card information online or with the front office.

## **FAMILY DISCOUNTS**

• There is a 5% tuition discount for siblings on the smaller tuition amount. There are also registration and recital fee discounts for 2nd and 3rd children in the family.

#### **REFUNDS/CREDITS**

- Refunds are only issued if Studio 3 cancels a class due to low enrollment and a suitable alternate option isn't available.
- Credits will be applied to tuition or fees within the current season.

## ATTENDANCE, ABSENCES, & MAKE-UP CLASSES

- Regular attendance is vital to student progress and group choreography. Please make every effort to attend each class.
- If your student must miss class, please report absences to the studio by phone (972) 964-3838 or email: studiothree.danceoffice@amail.com
- Students have the opportunity to make up missed class(es)
  within 30 days. (Makeups are not allowed in recital classes
  after March 1, 2026.) You may schedule make-ups at the
  front desk, by phone or using the above email.

#### CLASS CHANGES & WITHDRAWAL FROM CLASS

- All class changes should be made with the receptionist or director at the front desk, by phone, or by email.
- If it becomes necessary to withdraw from a class at any time, withdrawal must be submitted in writing with a 30-day notice.

# INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY, HOLIDAY CLOSINGS, & GOVERNMENT ADVISORY

- Studio 3 will follow the lead of Plano ISD concerning weather-related closings. If PISD is closed OR cancels after school activities, Studio 3 will be closed.
- Studio 3 will be closed Labor Day, PISD's October Break, Thanksgiving Week, PISD Winter Break, PISD Spring Break and the Saturday of Easter weekend. We are OPEN on MLK Day and President's Day when PISD is closed.

## **SAFETY**

- The studio lobby is open for drop off and pick up, and for parents with young dancers.
- Please do not drop off dancers more than 5-10 minutes before class time and pick up promptly as class ends.
   Dancers should never wait outside.

## **SPRING RECITAL**

- We end our season with a professional Spring Recital.
   Dance is a performing art and we encourage, but do not require participation.
- There will be a form to complete and turn in at the front desk no later than October 1st if you do not wish to participate and pay to have a recital costume ordered.
- Spring Recital dates are tentatively set for May 28 30.
- Specific show assignments will be published in late March.
